2024 New Garbage Collection Schedule: Beginning January 1, we will no longer be collecting every resident in the City on a single day each week. Some homes will experience a change to the day that their trash is collected. Please refer to your garbage collection schedule that was sent to you by County Hauling to confirm your new collection day. There will be a limit of ten (10) bags of trash (45 lbs per bag limit) and one (1) bulk item per week for each household. If a Holiday falls on a weekday, collection is pushed back one day for all days that follow. RECYCLING: As most of you know, we pick up bottles, jars, aluminum & bimetal cans at curb side. Please put your recyclables in your yellow bins and set them out the night before your pickup day. We will not pick up bins that have garbage or have food residue in them. The city also accepts newspapers, magazines, paperback books, workbooks, shredded cardboard and shredded paper only. **There are two small orange/green paper recycling bins** at the city garbage building where you can drop off these items at your convenience.

E-WASTE: Computers, Televisions and Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) will be picked up by special arrangements, at no charge, by County Hauling. Visit www.countyhauling.com/hhw-and-e-waste-recycling/ or call 724-929-7694 Ext. 2 (Monday thru Friday - 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.) New Kensington Residents only!

SPRING CLEANUP: This year spring cleanup is scheduled for Saturday, May 4, 2024 at the City Garage between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. This is the only time that the city has dumpsters available for residents to use. Please have proper ID ready for proof of residency. For more information, please call 724-335-5421.

BRANCHES: The street department will pick up branches during the months of **May thru September ONLY**. Branches must be between 2 and 8 feet long and no more than 8 inches in diameter, stacked neatly with cut ends facing the street. Call 724-335-5421 and we will put you on the branch pick up list. The chipper does not operate every day, please be patient for your pickup.

LEAVES: Leaves will be picked up during the months of **October and into December** as weather permits. Please rake leaves to the curb without creating a safety hazard. We have a schedule we follow that rotates throughout the city, which does not permit us to pick up leaves by special request. Please do not rake leaves out to the curb after the truck goes by and then call us to pick up your leaves. **We appreciate your cooperation.**

SNOW REMOVAL: We realize that everyone needs their street cleared as soon as possible. However, it is impossible to do all the streets at one time. Therefore, we follow these guidelines'-main arteries, bridges, and bypasses, etc., then hills, side streets and alleys.

MEMORIAL PARK: Reservations for Memorial Park pavilions are taken after the first of the year for bookings between Memorial Day and Labor Day. Please contact the Park's office from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday thru Friday, at 724-335-8005 for pricing, information and availability.

MASSA HARBISON: Reservations for Massa Harbison are taken by the City Clerk's office from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday, at 724-337-4523.
