



CITY OF NEW KENSINGTON COMMERCIAL RECYCLING INFORMATION

Businesses in the City of New Kensington must recycle! Pennsylvania's Municipal Waste Planning Recycling and Waste Reduction Act (Act 101) and the City's Solid Waste Code requires owners of commercial, municipal, and institutional properties to provide recycling services to tenants or occupants of their buildings. Not only is commercial recycling required, it is also important for preserving resources, reducing emissions, and improving the quality of life in our community.

Requirements

The following materials must be recycled by all businesses in the City:

- High-grade office paper
- Corrugated paper
- Aluminum
- Glass

Existing Program

A very high percentage of the business community contract with a private hauling company for the separate collection of recyclable materials. Please check the local directory for a list of companies that provide recyclable material collection services in the City.

Annual Report

A letter and annual report form is sent to all businesses in January of each year requiring all business to comply with Act 101. Please be advised that this report is **MANDATORY**. A copy of last year's letter and report is provided as an example.
